Londonderry

Eight: Myroe Levels, Lough Foyle. Six, 16th January to 6th February with two on 18th December (Neal Warnock *et al.*).

Up to 25: Myroe Levels, Lough Foyle. Nine birds, six adults and three juveniles were recorded 2nd February, three birds remaining to 7th February. 25 were then observed on 24th February only (David Nixon, Kerry Leonard *et al.*)
