

Russian White-fronted Goose *Anser albifrons albifrons* (0, 4, 41).

(Breeds northern Russia. Winters in Britain, France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, central Europe, central and eastern Turkey).

In contrast to the more familiar Greenland race *flavirostris*, this is the smaller nominate form of White-fronted Goose.

One: Ardmore, Lough Neagh, Derrytrasna, County Armagh, 14th to 15th February (David Knight *et al.*). *NIBA* 1994. *NIBA* 1994 states this is the first record for Northern Ireland.
