

Greater Yellowlegs *Tringa melanoleuca* (0, 4, 1).

(Breeds from southern Alaska across subarctic Canada east to Labrador and Newfoundland. Winters coastal USA, Central America, Caribbean and South America).

One: Downpatrick Marshes, Downpatrick, County Down, 18th December (Hill Dick, A. Hill, A. Thompson, S. Penney). *Ruttledge 1956*.

1962

One: Bog Meadows, Belfast, County Antrim, 14th to 16th April (L. Byrne *et al.*). *Ruttledge 1964*.

One: Three Islets, Lough Neagh, County Antrim, 2nd September (NIBRC). *Ruttledge 1963*.

One: Lough Beg NNR, County Londonderry, 22nd September (NIBRC). *Ruttledge 1963*.

1979

One: Lough Beg NNR, County Londonderry, 8th September (Raymond Hume / Antrim RSPB Group). *Preston 1980*.

2004

One: Adult. Quoile Pondage NNR, Downpatrick, County Down, 24th May to 15th June (Andrew Crory, Joe Lamont *et al.*). *Milne & McAdams 2008a*. This bird may have been present since 5th May when David Nixon had a distant Yellowlegs species.
