

Upland Sandpiper *Bartramia longicauda* (0, 1, 0).

(Breeds temperate and subarctic interior North America from south east Alaska through north west Canada to Mid-west and north east USA. Migrates through interior USA east of Rocky Mountains, Gulf of Mexico and Caribbean to winter South America from Brazil to Argentina).

One: Larne Lough [possibly River Inver], Larne, County Antrim, "sometime in the autumn" [23rd December?] (Colin Davidson). *NIBA* 1992.

A handful of feathers [no corpse] were picked up by Colin while out walking. The feathers were sent to P. Colston of the British Museum who identified them as belonging to an Upland Sandpiper. No corpse was found, just a handful of feathers.
