

Whiskered Tern *Sternula albifrons* (0, 0, 1).

(Breeds in small, scattered colonies through southern and eastern Europe from Iberia to Poland. Numerous and widespread from northern Black Sea east to western Kazakhstan, with Volga / Ural River complex holding most of European population, and Indian subcontinent to east and South East Asia. Winters tropical western and Central Africa from Nile Delta to east Africa. Other races occur east to southern Africa and Australia)
