

Black-billed Cuckoo *Coccyzus erythrophthalmus* (1, 0, 0).

(Breeds widely throughout temperate North America, from southern Alberta to Nova Scotia, Canada and south to northern Oklahoma, Tennessee and south-east Virginia. Winters South America, from Colombia to western Venezuela, and south to central Peru).

One: Shot. Killead, near Templepatrick, County Antrim, 25th September. *Blake-Knox* 1872.

The specimen was exhibited by P.L. Sclater to the Royal Zoological Society of London (*Anon. in PZS* 1873) and passed into the possession of Mr. H. Blake-Knox (*Ussher & Warren* 1900). The location of this specimen is currently unknown.
