

Golden Oriole *Oriolus oriolus* (9, 2, 2).

(Breeds Europe and western Asia. Winters central and southern Africa).

1824

One: Female. Donaghadee, County Down, 11th May. *Thompson* 1849; *Templeton* c.1824.

One: Male. Seen shortly after at the same location at Donaghadee, County Down. *Thompson* 1849; *Templeton* c.1824.

c1860

One: near Belfast, no date or locality, but probably around 1860 on the authority of H. Blake-Knox. *Ussher & Warren* 1900.

c1876

One: Dundonald, County Down on a date between 1876 and 1880. *Ussher & Warren* 1900; *Lloyd Patterson* 1891; *Kennedy, Rutledge & Scroope* 1954.

1881

One: Male. Found dead. Ballynahinch, County Down in May (*Ussher & Warren* 1900)3.

1913

Four: Near Roan House, Coalisland, County Tyrone, 11th May; one of these, a female was shot and is in the collection of the Ulster Museum (*Foster* 1913; *Wright* 1913; *McKee* 1989).

1953

One: Male. Ballygawley, County Tyrone 2nd October (D. Luke). *Rutledge* 1954.

1957

One: Present "in August", Banbridge, County Down (S. Buchanan). *Rutledge* 1958.

2013

One: Female. Islandhill, Comber, County Down, 15th November, photographed (Stefan Greif, Tessa Capelle). *Charles and Crory* 2019.

2017

One: Calling. Lackan Bog ASSI, Ballyroney, County Down, 9th July (Dave Allen, Andrew Crory). *Charles and Crory* 2019.
