

Red-rumped Swallow *Cecropis daurica* (0, 3, 0). **RV**

Breeds northwest Africa, Iberia, Balkans and Greece but uncommon in central Mediterranean. To the east breeds discontinuously in west and southern Turkey and Middle East. Assumed to winter in northern equatorial Africa).

One: Hillhead Crossroads, near Castledawson, County Londonderry, 18th November (Anthony McGeehan). *Preston 1983*.

1990

Two: Juveniles. Newcastle, County Down, 9th to 11th November (Leonard Charles *et al.*). *NIBA 1992*.

One: Reported. Dundrum, County Down, 18th November. *NIBA 1992*.

It is unclear if the NIBARC accepted the Dundrum bird, although it is published in their report, we are leaving it out of our totals.
