Two: Sandy Bay, Larne, County Antrim; one 18th - 23rd March (David Steele *et al.*) with two 24th March (David Steele *et al.*) *NIBA* 2000.

2000

Three: Briggs Rocks, Groomsport, County Down; one 3rd - 4th March (Martin Garner *et al.*) two 5th March (Walter Veale *et al.*) three [including one adult] 6th March one bird remaining to 22nd March (Martin Garner *et al.*). Note changes to *NIBA* 2002.

One: Carnfunnock, County Antrim, 17th March. *NIBA* 2001.

2001

One: Ringfad Point, Killough, County Down, 25th February - 17th March (David Steele). *NIBA* 2003.

Two: Ballygally, County Antrim, 11th March one remaining to 17th March (Davy Hunter). *NIBA* 2003.

2004

One: Red Bay, Waterfoot, County Antrim, 2nd - 8th March (Davy Hunter *et al.*). Note changes to *NIBA* 2006.

2005

One: Greencastle Point, Greencastle, County Down, 30th March (Frank Carroll). *Milne & McAdams* 2009.

2006

One: Glenarm, County Antrim, 17th March (Geoff Campbell). *Milne & McAdams* 2009.

2007

One: Sandy Bay, Larne, County Antrim, 18th March (Davy Hunter). *Milne & McAdams* 2009.
